19.00h **Design Your Business, Model Your Architecture** (Marc Lankhorst, BiZZdesign)

Marc Lankhorst managed the development of the enterprise architecture modelling language ArchiMate at the Telematica Instituut (later called Novay), in cooperation with representatives from government, industry and academia. Like TOGAF, ArchiMate is now an Open Group Standard.

In this presentation, Marc Lankhorst talks you through the history and development of ArchiMate, as he was involved in this success story from the very beginning. Marc also explains its background, goals and principles, and shares some success stories. Marc will also show how you can facilitate strategy implementation by relating strategic discussions on business models (e.g. using Alexander Osterwalder's Business Model Canvas) to enterprise architecture designs.

Of course, Marc hopes to convince the participants of the value of ArchiMate for their own practice. Wellfounded instruments help managers and architects to predict the effects of their actions, spot opportunities, and minimize risk, and the increasing use of such models and standards is a sure sign that our discipline is maturing.
