18h45 PIERA, OR THE STORY OF AN AIRPORT

WIM VAN THIENEN AND DIRK CORNETTE (BIAC)

- In 1997, Brussels International Airport Company (BIAC) decided to invest EUR 285.5 million in constructing a brand-new, 125.000m² extension: the PierA project.
- Teams involved in the project included airlines, groundhandlers, concession holders, architects, engineering consultancies, security companies, contractors, project companies ...
- 350 people from over 80 participating companies used a communication platform developed by the swITch business unit AsBuilt and based on OpenText's Livelink. AsBuilt Construction Groupware was used both for formal, legally-binding document exchange and for informal brainstorming and collecting best practices. Over 110,000 documents (including 27,500 CAD drawings) were exchanged during a 5-year period, and 12,000 items such as invoices and progress reports were reviewed and approved electronically.

Wim Van Thienen, senior project leader at Biac, and Dirk Cornette, account manager at swITch will elaborate on

how the platform was set up, on how the process was organised and on the lessons learned.
